Russia's Invasion of Ukraine

The Fighting That Began in 2014 Has Now Become a Full War

Our Sister Organizations Remain Active

The War May Have Temporarily Stopped Us from Going to Camp, but Our Sister Organizations Are Even More Active Now

Covid-19 prevented our teams from going to camp in Ukraine for two years, and now Russia's war against Ukraine prevents us, but we WILL return!

The war prevents our youth camp teams from being in Ukraine, but our sister organization, Good Samaritans, continues to work with orphans in Ukraine, in ways now more critical.

The orphans with whom we worked were scattered to safety, but now they are reforming and have great needs, which we supply. Good Samaritans was with them at the beginning of the war and we asked: "Do you fear the approaching army?" "No, you have taught us to trust in God, and we do."

Likewise, Kind House Ukraine Bakery has been even more active than ever. As people want to help, many have found our organization the perfect conduit since we continually supply basic needs to widows and orphans and all refugees of the war. And we have done so since its beginning in 2014.

KHUB is now in the process of expanding to a full, new storefront location to be able to produce and sell even more baked goods to raise funds for the assistance we provide.

Youth Camps in Ukraine

The Pioneer Youth Camps of what was once the Soviet Union are now privately-owned, government-run camps in Ukraine, for children aged 6 to 16.

Our organization has been active in the Ukrainian Youth Camps each summer for more than 15 years.

We organize teams of Americans to join with Ukrainian interpreters each summer to go into these camps to teach God's love through Bible stories, crafts, games, and by the example of how we act in our day-to-day inclusion in all camp activities.



We believe that Ukraine is central to the future of Europe. We were initially invited into the camps at the request of the Ukrainian government to help teach strong character traits to the next generation of Ukraine's leaders, because Ukraine is a young nation that needs moral and ethical leadership. BEYM holds to that same charter today.
