We have the Lord's supper by ourselves on the first Sunday and we celebrated one more opportunity to be a tool in God's hands to spread His word. We are going there every Sunday to have a Lord's supper together until we start our worship at the Church building.



We had great walks to try to find a place for the church to meet. Praise God we finally found one in a great neighborhood. The members already cleaned it up (lol). We were in a hurry to find one because our brothers from Arkansas are coming to help us to have a great start. They are coming May 30th. Please pray for them as they travel and work here in Foz. We are grateful for their time and willingness to come and help to start the church in Foz. God will do remarkable things; we believe.



The building is ready for the furniture: chairs, tables, baptistry, and supplies; praying for good places and prices to buy them.

We are happy to be here; like the sign on the right: no return beyond this point. We are here to start the Church of our Lord and savior and we will do it together. Together will go far.
